



CHEMISTRY FACULTY

Per-Hour Positions

Arkansas State University campus in Querétaro, México (A-State Campus Querétaro, or A-State CQ) invites applications for a faculty position to teach in the areas of General Chemistry, Biochemistry, Inorganic and Physical Chemistry. These are per-hour positions for fall 2020 and spring 2021.

THE POSITIONS

We are seeking dynamic, qualified colleagues who use modern methods and pedagogies in the classroom and laboratory. All faculty candidates must have a minimum of a Master's degree in chemistry (or related areas) with at least 18 graduate credit hours in the field. Preference will be given to candidates with a PhD and active research agendas. Additional preference will be given to candidates with educational and teaching experience in the United States. The language of instruction is English.

The appointees will be involved in teaching in one or more areas of Chemistry including General Chemistry I and II, Biochemistry/Biochemistry Lab, Physical Chemistry and Inorganic Chemistry. The successful candidate will contribute to teaching of introductory and upper level undergraduate courses in the Chemistry/Biological Science/Biotechnology and Engineering Programs.

Faculty must meet all relevant qualifications for similar employment at Arkansas State University. However, faculty will NOT become employees of Arkansas State University – instead, they will be employed by a private sector foundation registered in Mexico for this purpose. All non-Mexican national faculty members must qualify for employment as a foreign worker in Mexico, with this process being managed by A-State Querétaro at no cost to the faculty member.

Compensation in Mexican pesos will be guided by prevailing Mexican rates for university faculty with the expectation that A-State CQ intends to be a preferred employer among institutions of higher education in Mexico.

THE CAMPUS

A-State CQ is the first “American Style” comprehensive residential campus in Mexico and began teaching students in the fall of 2017. Through a multi-national public-private partnership, Arkansas State University, accredited by the Higher Learning Commission, with the Campus Queretaro also accredited by SEP, offers degrees in Chemistry, Biological Sciences, Biotechnology, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, International Business, Business Administration, and Strategic Communication.

Located in the highlands of central Mexico two hours north of Mexico City, Santiago de Querétaro (1.8m) is a UNESCO World Heritage city and one of the fastest growing and safest in Mexico. Home to more than 1,300 multi-national corporations, international interest in Querétaro has increased because of its economic growth, high quality of life, social progress and its year-round temperate climate.
